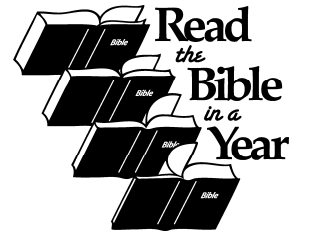
FREE LADIES ZUMBA CLASS
